Recently a former student of St. Ann's Grade School in Newark passed away. Colleen and her siblings had all attended St. Ann's in the mid-1960s. During the wake service, a neighboring parish priest led us in prayer. At the conclusion of his reflection, he admonished wake goers not to come to say goodbye to Colleen but rather it was best to say, "See you later!"

That simple, ordinary phrase captures the heart of our belief in the Resurrection—a mystery that even the disciples in today's Gospel didn't get:

"For they (disciples) did not yet understand the  
Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead."

So, on this marvelous feast of Easter—the Resurrection of Jesus—may we say to all our dearly departed:

"See you later!"
